



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### Report on Lecture Series On Mentoring - Theory And Practice - I



# Report on Lecture Series On Mentoring - Theory And Practice - II






#### REPORT ON Ulektz IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM

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
### REPORT ON TEACHER QUALITIES AND TEAM BUILDING

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




## Report on Reformation on Regulation







NBA became Autonomous in January 2010 and in April 2013 the Memorandum of Association and Rules of NBA were amended to make it completely independent of AICTE, administratively as well as financially. NBA now independent in its functioning: decision making as well as financially.

Does not receive any grant either from the government or from any regulatory body of technical and higher education. Accreditation is a process of quality assurance and improvement, whereby a programme in an approved Institution is critically appraised to verify that the Institution or the programme continues to meet and/or exceed the Norms and Standards prescribed by regulator from time to time. It is a kind of recognition which indicates that a programme or Institution fulfills certain standards.

GENERAL POLICY ON ACCREDITATION the following general policies are the guiding principles for the accreditation of programs:

1. Programs, and not Educational Institutions, are considered for accreditation.

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- 2. Programs to be accredited should be offered by an educational Institution which has been formally approved as an educational Institution by the concerned regulatory authority.
- 3. Programs from which at least two batches of students have graduated will be considered for accreditation.
- 4. Programs are considered for assessment and accreditation only at the written request of the educational institution and after agreeing to abide by the NBA's accreditation manual, rules, regulations and notification issued from time to time

The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

- Combined Metric for Faculty with Ph.D and Experience (FQE).
- Metric for Library and Laboratory Facilities (LL).
- Metric for Sports and Extra-Curricular Facilities, Activities(SEC).

### Research, Professional Practice:

The faculty members are expected to make their knowledge and expertise available to benefit the society and industry. This parameter,

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therefore, attempt to measure the quantity and quality of research output as seen through international data bases, IPR generation and interface with industry and fellow professionals.

#### **Graduation Outcomes:**

This parameter forms the ultimate test of the effectiveness of the core teaching/learning activity, and measures the student graduation rate and their success in finding appropriate placement in industry and Government or taking up higher studies.

#### Outreach:


The Ranking framework lays special emphasis on representation of women and socially challenged persons in student and/or faculty populations, and also on outreach activities of the institution.


