Instructions to the Candidate

- 1. A printed copy of this Admit Card must be presented for verification along with the original (not photocopy or scanned copy) valid photo identification proof which is mentioned in the admit card as well. In case of poor quality of photo on ID proof or electronic ID, candidate MUST bring an additional recent valid photo ID also (For example: Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID, Aadhaar Card, College ID, Employee ID, Driving License).
- 2. Admit Card is considered to be valid only if both the photograph and signature are clear. To ensure this, print this admit card on A4 sized paper using laser printer, preferably in colour.
- . Candidates will be permitted to appear for the examination ONLY after verification of their credentials by the centre officials.
- 4. To facilitate the verification of their identity, candidates must report at the examination venue at least 60 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination.
- 5. Candidates will be permitted to occupy their seats 40 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination. Candidates can login and start reading the instructions 20 minutes before start of the examination.
