




1. How would you rate the faculty completes the syllabus in time as per the course objectives?





1	More co-curricular activities that should include the latest trends in technology are required.	Seminars, webinars, conferences, and special workshops with hands-on sessions are done periodically using the latest IT tools.
2	Need more awareness about job-related scenarios and improving employability.	The college has arranged various initiatives to improve placement training with current trends in industry and in consultation with experts to provide a holistic development of students' employability in the current scenario.
3	Need for an increase in core placement	More MOUs were signed with core companies, and more students attended internships and in-plant trainings at core companies.
4	Need more quality time in Alumni Interaction.	An alumni talk series has been arranged to increase the interaction of current students with outside industrial needs and skills.
5	Need more quality time for alumni interaction.	More industrial visits have been arranged, and industry-supported laboratories are being set up
